Dear Members of the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors,

On behalf of The Producers Guild of America, I write to express our support for Supervisor Lindsey Horvath's motion directing Los Angeles County to evaluate the potential economic impacts of the proposed Paramount–Skydance acquisition of Warner Bros.

Los Angeles County is the global capital of the entertainment industry, and thousands of local jobs and small businesses depend on a strong and competitive creative economy. When production slows or industry consolidation occurs, the impacts are felt across our communities—from producers to performers and crew members to small vendors and small businesses that support film and television production.

Major studio mergers have historically resulted in layoffs, reduced competition, and fewer opportunities for workers and creators. It is critical that Los Angeles County proactively evaluate the potential impacts of industry consolidation.

Supervisor Horvath's motion takes an important step by directing the County's Department of Economic Opportunity to conduct a comprehensive economic impact study and develop an action plan to support entertainment workers, the businesses dependent on film and television production, and the broader creative economy.

For these reasons, we urge the Board of Supervisors to support this motion.
